School Uniform

Our school uniform should support learning by being safe, comfortable and minimising distraction to learning. Wearing a shared, smart uniform to school helps to reinforce the feeling amongst pupils that:

- We enjoy our shared identity as a school
- We care about our personal presentation as well as the presentation of our learning

School Uniform

- Ide Navy polo shirts
- Ide Green sweatshirts or cardigans
- Grey dresses, skirts, trousers, culottes or shorts
- Green checked summer dresses, skirts or culottes
- Black shoes (not trainers)
- Plain coloured socks (black, grey or white)
- Jewellery should be kept to a minimum. Stud earrings or hair bands or clips may be worn but large bows etc. can become a distraction to learning and so are not suitable. Necklaces are not suitable for safety reasons.
- Hair that is longer than shoulder length should be fully up

PE Kit

PE is a key aspect of our curriculum and one which children very much enjoy.

Please ensure that your child has the correct PE kit at all times. This should include:

- Green Ide PE T shirt
- Black or grey shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms in cold weather
- Trainers or plimsolls and socks

We ask children to wear their PE Kit on the day when your child has PE which they will keep on all day.

Support

We will have an informal discussion with parents if pupils do not have the correct items of uniform to see how we can support. If there are any questions regarding the school uniform or PE kit, parents and carers are encouraged to speak to school staff who will always seek ways to help.
