Linguists are learning...

- To talk in front of a small group.
- To answer questions in front of whole class.
- To develop the confidence to talk to other adults they see on a daily basis.
- To share their work to the class- standing up at the front.
- To link statements and stick to a main theme.
- To talk to different adults around the school.
- To learn new vocabulary.
- To use new vocabulary throughout the day.
- To talk in sentences using conjunctions e.g. and, because.
- To use new vocabulary in different contexts.
- To engage in non-fiction books.
- To use talk to organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas, feelings and events.
- To talk about why things happen.
- To talk in sentences using a range of tenses.

At the end of the year Linguists can...

- Participate in small group, class and one-to-one discussions, offering their own ideas, using recently introduced vocabulary.
- Offer explanations for why things might happen, making use of recently introduced vocabulary from stories, non-fiction, rhymes and poems when appropriate.
- Express their ideas and feelings about their experiences using full sentences including use of past, present and future tenses and making use of conjunctions, with modelling and support from their teacher.
